The mission of the Pagan Snow Cap Microregional Association is to improve the quality of life of locals by respecting natural values and traditions.

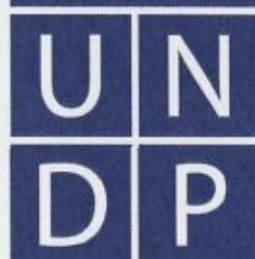
Vision

Mountain hay meadows - hot spots of biodiversity and traditional culture

Objective:

The objective of the project is that farmers from Csík and Gyimes realize, that the farming they practice is not only important from the point of view of earning a living, but it is also this farming that ensures the sustainability of the landscape, which is of great value to the urban population as well as to the whole of Europe. Its value lies in its aesthetic beauty and the biodiversity created by traditional farming; a wide variety of plants and animals are present on the meadows and grasslands. These can only be preserved through continuing traditional farming, which also plays an important role in ensuring the living of farmers, the elimination of poverty, and maintaining the ability of the rural world to sustain its inhabitants.

Location:

1. Delne (Pálfalva commune)
2. Hidegségpataka (Gyimesközéplak)

Timeline:

2009. 1st of September 2011. 1st of March

Main objectives:

- To create a database on hay meadow biodiversity
- To create integrated management plans for two sites
- To create benefits for landowners from biodiversity and sustainable land use

Activities:

- Creating a workgroup, where everyone concerned will be represented; local population, researchers, institutions involved.
- Conducting research in cooperation with Hungarian, English and local experts, and at least 30 university students. Integrating project results in local school curricula and outdoor activities
- Organizing a one-week summer camp next year in Gyimesközéplak, where the results of the research will be presented, and which will also provide opportunity for exchange of knowledge and best practices.
- consulting local farmers about land use at the two locations



- Compiling management plans and best practices guide
- Proposing sites to be included in the Natura 2000 network.
- Increasing income from milk production (e.g. cheese making training course, purchase of equipment to meet milk quality standards)
- Organizing an international conference on biodiversity, traditional farming and related European policies to promote 2010 the International Year of Biodiversity.
- Creating environmental education trails in the Torda valley, in Delne.
